

1st Lateran Council (1123), Canon 7

« Presbyteris, diaconibus veta subdiaconibus concubinarum et uxorum contubernia penitus interdicimus et aliarum mulierum cohabitationem, praeter quas synodus Nicaenac propter solas necessitudinum causase habitare permisit, videlicet matrem sororem amitam velf materteram aut alias huiusmodi, de quibus nulla iuesteg valeat suspicio oririh. »

We absolutely forbid priests, deacons or subdeacons to live with concubines and wives, and to cohabit with other women, except those whom the council of **Nicaea** permitted to dwell with them solely on account of necessity, namely a mother, sister, paternal or maternal aunt, or other such persons, about whom no suspicion could justly arise
